Graduation

1. Will there still be a graduation ceremony?

At this time the graduation ceremony has not been cancelled. Remember, Seniors at the The Success Center (PLC, VA, and Project Eclipse) graduate with their base high school. The graduation days and times are as follows:

CHHS is May 21st at 2:30 pm

AHS is May 21st at 7pm

LSHS is May 22nd at 10am

NMHS is May 22nd at 2:30pm

DCHS is May 22nd at 7pm

2. What happens if the graduation date approaches and the Shelter in Place is extended past our graduation date?

Alternate dates for graduation

July 21 for AHS and CHHS (Same start time)

July 22 for DCHS, LSHS, and NMHS (Same start time)

3. What if I want refund for my cap and gown? Or a refund for my announcements?

Those items were purchased through Herff Jones and not the base high schools. Any refunds would come from Herff Jones.

4. What if I want to purchase a cap and gown?

5. What if I did not pick up my purchased cap and gown?

May 11, 10am-2pm (*CHHS, LSHS, and NMHS*)

May 12, 10am-2pm (*AHS and DC*)

Note: These dates are subject to change, depending on COVID-19 guidance from the Governor and District Leaders.

1. Will there still be a prom?
